AN EPIC EPISTEMIC EXISTENTIAL CRISIS:

- 1) Ideological manipulation: liberalism, secularism, scientism, feminism, etc.
- 2) Social pressures: identity crisis, moral confusion, blind imitation (loss of independent reasoning)
- 3) Economic process (supported by media & technology) leading to manufactured consent and undermining of self-determination.

2 ISLAMIC EDUCATION SHORTFALL

Failure to equip young Muslims to navigate and respond to the existential challenges confronting them.

Rote memorization and emphasis on ritualism leading to mechanical understanding while lacking spiritual, intellectual, moral depth.

3 KEY DEFICIENCIES

- 1) Rote ritualism: education focused on a mechanical performance of rituals.
- 2) Vulnerability to ideological manipulation
- 3) **Moral relativism:** lacking guidance on emerging domains and social challenges.
- 4) **Priority misalignment:** inability to balance between religion, profession, family, community, and ummah.
- 5) **Juristic Confusion:** lacking legal reasoning or evidence.
- 6) **System rigidity:** causing teacher burnout and student alienation.

A PARADIGM SHIFT IN ISLAMIC EDUCATION...

... from ta'leem model to a tarbiyyah model (includes coaching and mentorship) rooted in usul al-din, empowering young Muslims with:

- 1. Critical thinking
- 2. Spiritual grounding
- 3. Moral leadership
- 4. Jurisprudential reasoning

5 ISLAMIC EDUCATION RENEWAL

Design an usul al-din based educational model bridging the empowerment gap:

Centered around tarbiyyah to holistically develop the nafs (inner-self) -- fitra, aql (mind), qalb (heart), & ruh (soul).

Equip students with intellectual humility, spiritual resilience & moral clarity.

KEY (PROPOSED) SOLUTIONS

- 1) Tazkiyyah and Tadabbur-centered learning for purposeful living.
- 2) **Critical thinking development** by harmonizing reason with revelation.
- 3) **Akhlaq and Maqasid Lab:** exploring realworld dilemmas for moral confidence
- 4) Realigning priorities by distinguishing **Parūriyyāt, Ḥājiyyāt, & Taḥsīniyyāt.**
- 5) **Scaffolding usul al-fiqh**: to understand sources and principles to contextualize legal reasoning and Islamic scholarship.
- 6) Developing **transformational leadership**: inspiring role-models and moral mentors.
